Title	Seminar on Public Private Partnership I I4
Sub-Title	To foster skills and expertise on PPP by analyzing, assessing and evaluating various concrete PPP transactions both in Japan as well as abroad.
Language	Japanese and/or English
Course Purpose and Content	To pick up typical concrete transactions (domestic or abroad) on infrastructure PPP, understand their substance and various practices and to build up knowledge and skills so that such could help in forging expertise in structuring and scheming similar practices.
Learning Objectives	To foster fundamental capability/knowledge of participating students on PPP practices. This enables to use various tools and methods available in concrete transactions.
Seminar Schedule	<p>It is intended to pick up concrete transaction examples (both for success and failure, the latter if available) from the following different fields of PPP at each seminar. The participating students are requested to gather available data, sum-up the transaction, assess and evaluate the project for debates;</p> <p>The seminars shall be conducted under following schedule/contents, which may be amended depending on the circumstances(It is intended that for some fields may continue for a few seminars):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Introduction (approaches, concept, assignments)</li> <li>2. Power/Energy(power generation, transmission, retail. Renewables)</li> <li>3. Highway</li> <li>4. Railway(High Speed Rail, MRT, LRT)</li> <li>5. Airport (Concession lease)</li> <li>6. Port Terminal(Container terminal development)</li> <li>7. Water supply/Sewage network</li> <li>8. Waste incineration, Waste to energy</li> <li>9. Hospital, social care facilities</li> </ol>

Instructional Method	Based on above overall schedule, instructions shall be given for specific transactions/themes for participating students to conduct pre-study
